We celebrate The Ascension of the Lord (World Communications Day)

The ascension marks the transition from the first part of the Easter season to the second. Today marks the close of this stage when Jesus is no longer visibly present to his church. Rosary for Peace: On Tuesday, 31 May, at 6pm, (5pm Irish Time) Pope Francis will lead a Rosary for peace as a sign of hope for those suffering from the ongoing war in Ukraine and wars around the world. "At the conclusion of the Marian month, Pope Francis wishes to offer a sign of hope to the world, suffering from the conflict in Ukraine and deeply wounded by the violence of the many wars still active." The Pope will pray the Rosary before the statue of Mary Regina Pacis in Rome's Marian Basilica. "All the faithful in every part of the world are invited to support Pope Francis in his prayer to the Queen of Peace," the statement encouraged. A number of Shrines, including The Shrine of Our Lady of Knock, will pray the Rosary at the same time as the Holy Father, and will be connected via streaming to the live broadcast from Rome.
