GOSPEL - REFLECTION

Lord, remember me (Lk 23:35-43)

On the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year, today, we celebrate the Feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Universal King. Today's feast puts before us Jesus as a person who never used power for his own selfish advantage. The power of God is shown in an unexpected way in the crucifixion, with Jesus sharing our human weakness.

Jesus is an example of someone in apparent helplessness. In human terms he was powerless. It was his trust in the love of God for him that helped him through. It was only later with the hindsight of the resurrection that the moment of helplessness could be seen as one in which the power of God was present.

May Christ support us all the day long. till the shadows lengthen, and the evening comes, and the busy world is hushed, and the fever of life is over and our work is done.

Then in his mercy may he give us a safe lodging, a holy rest and peace at the last. Amen.
