'A voice cries in the wilderness' (Mt 3:1-12)

John the Baptist came to bear witness to Jesus. John appears in the story as one who had the courage to be himself in the face of opposition. He was also a person who knew his own value, did not make exaggerated claims and was content with his mission. John was 'the voice of the one crying in the wilderness' - announcing confidently to those in the wilderness that they must not despair because God's grace may come to them at any moment.
