First Sunday of Lent 26 February 2023 GOSPEL REFLECTION

'Jesus is tempted' (Mt4:1-11)

In today's gospel Jesus is enticed to gratify his own needs, or to perform some spectacular act in public. He rejects the temptation because he chooses commitment to his mission and to dependence in his Father over any immediate gratification. We can all be tempted to go for some immediate satisfaction, but is that where happiness lies?

One way of looking at this Gospel is to say that Jesus went into the desert to face his demons. We all have demons we need to face - compulsions, fears, prejudices, anger, and urges that lurk within. It is in facing our demons that we find a way to a fuller life.

In one of her reflections Joyce Rupp describes Lent as 'a time to rediscover lost treasures'. Is there something that once was a healthy part of your life and is no longer there: e.g., reading, exercise, mindfulness, prayer, socialising, fun? Would this Lent be a time to rediscover that lost treasure?
