## GOSPEL REFLECTION

'In truth this was a son of God'
Mt 26:14-27:66

Where am $I$ in the unfolding drama that begins on Palm Sunday and plays out over Holy Week and which climaxes on Easter? Where am I as Jesus passes by on the donkey? Am I one of the crowd shouting out his name? Am I like Judas in any way? When have I betrayed others or Jesus? When like Peter, have I denied knowing Jesus? Am I like Pilate when I judge and condemn others? How am I like Simon or Veronica who helped Jesus in his time of need. Having stood with the crowd shouting out his name and welcoming Jesus, will I stand with then same people spitting out insults as I shout 'Crucify him! Crucify him!'

As we celebrate Palm/Passion Sunday and begin our journey through Holy Week, we are called to ask ourselves, who and where we are in the crowd. This is a week to pray and then decide what kind of followers of Christ we are going to be.
As we begin this most holy of weeks, may Jesus be our companion. May we enter the mystery of Jesus' life, death and resurrection with faith and hope.
