'I am the gate of the sheepfold' John 10:1-10

In the Middle-East, it was the task of the shepherd to find water and pasture and to ensure safety.

Important to the shepherd's ability to give security to the sheep is the fact that he was known and familiar to them.

We are all familiar with the image of Jesus as the shepherd. The image of Jesus as the door (or gate) is not so familiar but is one that merits attention. Jesus presents himself as the door (gate) through which we pass and find life. The Gospel calls us not to be half alive, but to be fully alive. Let us enter by the gate himself, because the gate to life is always open.
