Sixth Sunday of Easter 14 May 2023 **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

'The Father will give you another Advocate' John 14:15-21

'If you love me, you will keep my commandments', and specifically the commandment to love one another. Jesus is preparing his disciples for his imminent departure and for a future in which he would be with them in a different way. He would not 'leave them orphans' but send them an 'Advocate' to be with them forever.

Perhaps you have also experienced the challenge of preparing another (a child, a friend) for a time when you would no longer be physically together.

Regardless of the circumstances of our lives, we have never been and never will be orphaned by God. The proof of the ongoing presence of Jesus with his disciples is that 'I live and you will live'. Discipleship is about much more than rules and regulations. It is about being alive, fully alive!
