Trinity Sunday 04 June 2023 GOSPEL REFLECTION

'God loved the world so much' Jn 3:16-18

When we speak of God as Trinity, we are speaking of God as love, reaching out to embrace is all. Today's feast reminds us that the primary movement is of God towards us, rather than of us towards God. God's movement of towards us in love is always a given; it does not depend on how good we are or how well we are living.

The Trinity is not something that we can understand and figure out with our reasoning, intellect or with our brain. We most certainly won't find the explanation to the Trinity by 'googling' it!

When we look at the news on our television or read the newspapers any day, we are often presented with news of violence, segregation and building walls. Sadly there is division where there could be unity, there is aggression where there could be understanding, and there is suspicion where there could be trust and respect

The Trinity offers us a model of sharing, belonging and community. It also challenges our individualism and our demand that our rights be met all

the time. The Trinity asks us to be mindful of our responsibilities to those around us in our families, our neighbourhood and our Faith Community.
