Twenty First Sunday, Year A 27 August 2023 SATINATION GOSPEL REFLECTION

Mt 16:13-20

When Jesus presses the question, who do you say I am?, we feel him speaking to us. Naturally, we think of our faith now in the light of our own journey of life and pilgrimage of faith. How did I start out? What was my image of Jesus then and how did I relate to him? How have I deepened my familiarity with Jesus and who is he for me now?

The word 'Church' is often a stumbling block for many. There is something which makes us feel uncomfortable! The Gospel today presents to us the Faith Statement of Peter, and then Jesus declaring to him that '....on this rock, I will build my Church; and the gates of the underworld can never hold out against it.'

The Church is not a mere building; the Church is the People of God. We reduce the Church in our everyday vocabulary to a mere building made of stones and cement. But, the Church is made of living stones (1Pt 2:5) and all of us need to contribute to keeping alive this Church of God. Do I give my share of talents and gifts to the Church to keep it effective and relevant for our modern times?
