03 December 2023 GOSPEL REFLECTION

'Stay awake, because you do not know when the master of the house is coming' . Mk 13:33-37

Staying awake is not easy; it is really quite hard. This First Sunday of Advent invites me to reflect on my daily life - for what do I ask forgiveness? For what do I give thanks? We also look forward to a new beginning and a chance to start again on the way of discipleship. Both thanksgiving and renewal are to be found in today's readings. The Gospel is an invitation to wake up, to keep watch, to live fully the present moment under God, in whom we live and move and have our being.

Because Christians have always recognised the importance of waiting and preparation, they intentionally built periods of waiting into the Christian calendar. This is a way of making room for this important piece of life that the world is so eager to get rid of. It slows us down, reorients us around God and gives us time to reflect, to prepare, to rest.

Advent is one of those seasons of waiting. When we come to Advent we remember the promise that Christ has come and will come again, but we also remember that we are not ready to jump headlong into celebration. First we must prepare. Waiting is a gift. Let us be ready for the sweetness that has come and is coming again.
