Gospel Reflection

'We should like to see Jesus' Jn 12:20-30

The parable of the grain of wheat reminds us of a truth that any parent can testify to, namely that it is in dying to ourselves that we can give life to others. We will never be of benefit to others if we remain wrapped up in ourselves.

Sometimes our emotions rebel at the thought of what lies ahead, and we feel like praying 'Father, save me from this hour.' Then a realisation may come for you: No, it is for this reason that I have come to this hour.

Some of us become overwhelmed by life's contradictions. The pain and injustice that we see on every side may cause us to lose all faith in God and in life. That could have happened to Jesus. If ever there was a person who had the right to doubt God, and to despair of the human race and to become cynical about life, that person was Jesus. But through all of His injustices and all of the pain, His faith did not fail. He kept on believing in God, unlike many of us, He kept on believing in people, He kept on believing in life. At Calvary, faith won.
