Gospel Reflection

'I am the good shepherd' In 10:11-18

In this day of prayer for Vocations, the image put before us in the liturgy to describe the person and work of Jesus among his disciples is that of a shepherd. The sight of a shepherd leading the sheep to pasture would be a familiar sight to Jesus' listeners. We are told that in the Holy Land shepherds lead the sheep rather than drive them. Two aspects of this are Following important. someone involves a free choice, and to follow someone means to have confidence in their ability to lead.

God doesn't call the qualified, but He qualifies the called! God knows us and He calls us by name. As we look at different saints to learn from them, we remember that others look to us and learn from us. And as our struggles become real, even as others turn to us for guidance, we also have a shepherd to turn to for help. Most of us sometimes forget this, but we are leaders in our own way.

The church of tomorrow depends on how we set the foundation for the church of today. There will be crisis and there will be need, but there will always be good people standing behind and beside us.
