

Meeting with Minister Foley, Leinster House, Wed. 1st May. In attendance; Minister Kieran O'Donnell, Deputy Willie O'Dea, Denis Murray, Acting Chairperson, Carmel Stokes, Deputy Principal and Ian Madigan, School Principal.

The minister met and engaged with us for 45 minutes. We were given the opportunity to make a comprehensive presentation outlining the current condition of the school in its entirety, the educational challenges posed by such on a daily basis and the timeline of the building project to date. The minister listened intently to our case and has assured us that our school is now at the forefront of her and the department's attention. She expressed concern around the adequacy of special educational needs provision and for the consideration of the new build to accommodate additional special classes.

Minister Foley has committed to engaging with all relevant Department of Education officials on this and to coming back to us with a response in the coming weeks.
