The Ascension of the Lord 12th May 2024

Gospel Reflection

'He was taken up into heaven' Mk 16:15-20

The ascension marked the end of the visible presence of Jesus with the disciples, but he would be with them in other ways. We can experience that death is not the end of the presence of someone significant for us. We can experience the unseen presence of and influence of a parent, a friend or inspiring leader, even after they have died.

Leonardo da Vinci had started to work on a large canvas in his studio. Then suddenly he stopped working on it. Summoning one of his talented students, the master invited him to complete the work. The horrified student protested that he was both unworthy and unable to complete the great painting which his master had begun. But da Vinci silenced him. 'Will not what I have done inspire you to do your best?'

Jesus our master began to spread the Good News two thousand years ago by what he said and did, and supremely by what he suffered. Jesus illustrated his message and left us to finish the picture. This is the message of the Ascension.
